Equates to 30 days off school each year	85%	Very Concerned

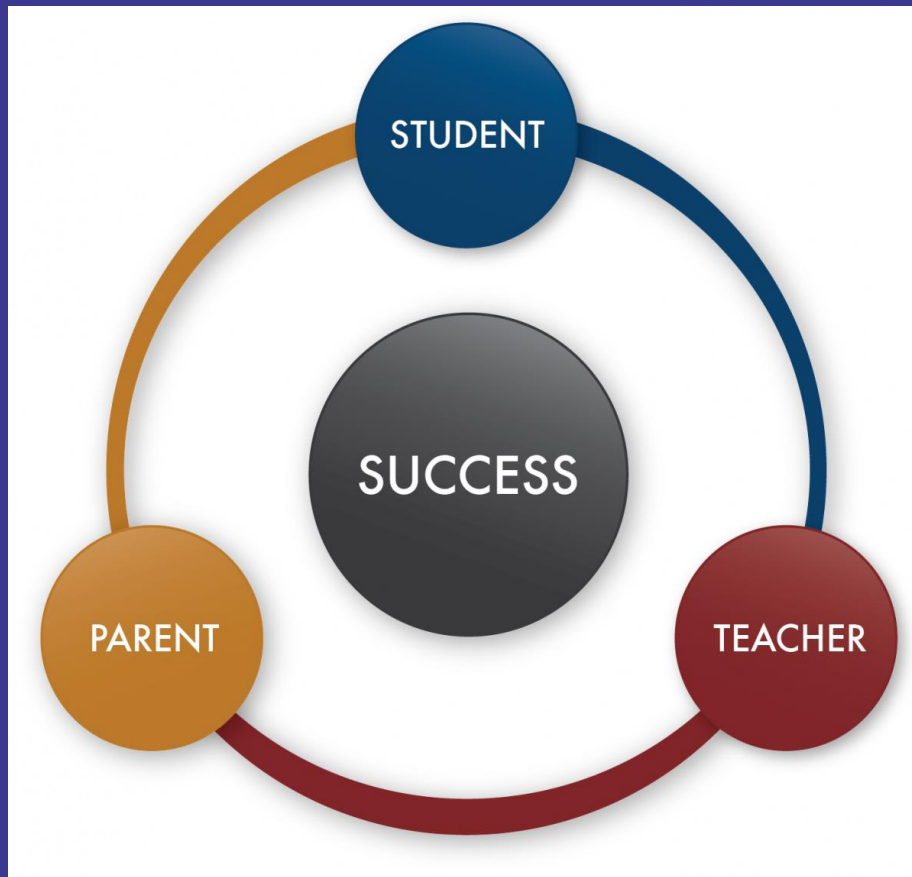

Achieving Together

1. In Year 7 and 8, students will have their assessment marked in percentages.
2. GCSE grades will begin to be used in Year 9 as well as percentages.

Assessment, Exams and Reporting

Achieving Together

1. Every lesson teachers are assessing your child on what they know and how they apply their knowledge
2. All subjects will do between 3-6 formal assessments per year and students will get feedback on how to improve
3. There will be one exam window which will be on the 17th June.
