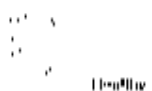

Dear Parent

As part of the Opening Minds programme in year 7 we are offering gifted and talented students an extension and enrichment programme to complement the work being undertaken at school.

Students have been exploring the situation of refugees in recent classes and an exciting opportunity has arisen locally with a new touring art show directed at children in years 7-11 called *Children at War*. The show runs as part of the Eastbourne Festival and takes place at the Redoubt Fortress and Military Museum. We have arranged for a small number of students to be able to attend the exhibition, which is timed between 10 am and 12.00 on 28th April. (A school bus has been arranged to take them to and from the exhibition).

Children at War is all about the effects of war, both traditional and gang warfare, on children globally. It covers human rights, child soldiers, refugees, suicide bombers, orphans, gangs, knife and gun crime. The show has been organised by 'Highlight' a voluntary organisation of artists who are raising awareness and funds for 'Warchild' a registered charity who help children in warzones. The lead artist for Highlight, Clare Hackney, lives here in Eastbourne and has used an exciting mix of portraiture, collage (using the United Nations Treaty of Children's Rights) and spray painting with stencils to illustrate the themes. 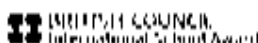

Your son/daughter is taking part in an exciting project during Opening Minds where every year 7 pupil is given 10 free lessons on a musical instrument. This Band Project will be delivered by two experience musicians in residence from the East Sussex Music Service, Aiden McConville and Duncan Purvey.

Through learning an instrument it is hoped that pupils will learn important life skills such as team work, discipline and concentration as well as important musical skills. We will be offering clarinet, trumpet, cornet, baritone and trombone.

The project should prove to be an exciting new experience for the pupils and will end with an informal concert/presentation of the pieces they have learnt to play.

For your child to get the most from the lessons they will need to take the instrument home to practice. Not only is this necessary for their progress but it will require them to be responsible for it's care. The pupils must remember to bring the instrument into school every Friday and place it in the instrument store cupboard in the music department until their lesson.

There are currently 3 vacancies for Parent Governors on the Governing Body. If you wish to stand for election as a Parent Governor of the School, please complete the enclosed nomination form.

Parent governors play a very important role in keeping the Governing Body aware of the views of parents and the local community. They are a vital part of the governing body and I hope that there are parents willing to give their time and commitment to this important role. A commitment to serving as part of a team and an enthusiasm for the work of the governing body is paramount to a successful governing body. Governors do not work independently and you will be supported in your role. New governors will be offered an opportunity to attend induction training run by CfBT Education Services to assist them.

Parents are disqualified from election or appointment as a parent governor if:

- they are paid to work at the School for more than 500 hours in a School year
- they are an elected member of the Local Education Authority.


If more than three nominations are received, I shall arrange for parents to receive ballot papers which will include the candidates' election statements, and a vote will then have to take place.

Completed nomination papers must be returned to the School no later than 12 mid-day on Tuesday 11 May 2010. There will be a box placed in the main Reception for your child to post the nomination paper; **all nomination papers will be void if not placed in this box.**

Votes will be counted at 12 mid-day on Tuesday 11 May 2010. Candidates may attend the count. I shall arrange for all parents to be notified of the result, through our Connections Magazine which is issued to all parents.

- I am not subject to a disqualification order under the Company Directors Act 1986;
- I am not subject to an order made under section 492(2) (b) of the Insolvency Act 1986;
- I have not been removed from the office of charity trustee or trustee for a charity by the Charity Commissioners or High Court on grounds of any misconduct or management;
- I am not included in the list of people considered by the Secretary of State as unsuitable to work with children;
- I am not disqualified from working with children or subject to a direction under section 142 of the Education Act 2002;
- I am not disqualified from registration for child minding or providing day care;
- I am not disqualified from registration under Part 3 of the Childcare Act 2006;
- I have not received a sentence of imprisonment (whether suspended or not) for a period of not less than three months in the five years before becoming a governor or since becoming a governor;
- I have not received a prison sentence of 2.5 years or more in the 20 years before becoming a governor;
- I have not at any time received a prison sentence of five years or more;
- I have not been fined for causing a nuisance or disturbance on school premises during the five years prior to or since appointment or election as a governor;
- I do not refuse to allow an application to the Criminal Records Bureau for a criminal records certificate.
