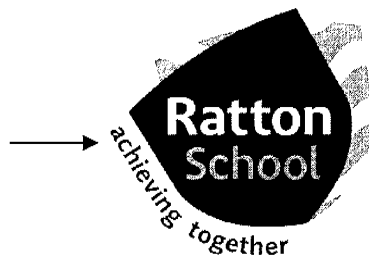
GUIDELINES FOR YOUR DESIGN
